Recently I had the privilege of attending a Mass at Sacred Heart Church in Denver to honor Our Lady of Knock. The homily that Sunday was given by Deacon Ruben Estrada and his words hit home. After Mass Deacon Ruben told me I was free to share some part of his homily with you.

[“Are we a people who serve God with our lips, but are hearts are far from Him? Are we a people who fail to demonstrate Christian love and mercy? If Jesus were here today would He look upon our actions and call us hypocrites? The commandment given to us by Christ was to love one another. In demonstrating our Christian love we give others the opportunity to change so that they may experience, not God’s wrath, but His tender care and compassion. Love today for tomorrow might be too late. Yesterday has passed and tomorrow is not certain. It may be too late to say the words, “I love you” or to say, “I forgive you”, or “can we start over”. It may be too late to ask for forgiveness or to realize out mistakes, don’t forsake anything for tomorrow. Look, ask, insist and try again. Today is a gift and tomorrow is never promised. Look for Jesus today because tomorrow is uncertain. Today, He invites us to change our hearts for tomorrow may be too late.”]

I came away from Deacon Ruben’s homily feeling that now is the time to try to heal those hurts. 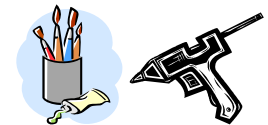
